Reaching Children

Thank you so much for your prayers during our time here in Canada. The biggest change in our family is that Timothy is back in Bolivia. He was not adjusting well here and wanted to be in Bolivia where he could train for soccer every day to reach his dream of becoming a professional soccer player. He was immediately accepted on a competitive team in Cobija, and is also playing his guitar in church and for the orphanage boys to prepare special music. Pray that the Lord will protect him from the many temptations a teenage boy away from home faces. Pray also for Janessa. After graduation she will take a year off before attending Prairie Bible College so that she can work on improving her health, during which time she will study part time. Grace is taking ballet classes and missing her brother, so she is looking forward to returning to Bolivia.

At Hogar Shalom we have also seen some changes. Pastor Ruperto and his wife Adela decided to leave us suddenly in January. Unfortunately he did arrange for the new children to enter the orphanage and lost contact with them. Praise the Lord that two days after he announced he was leaving, Lorgio and Yovana approached Jose saying they felt God had put it on their hearts to be parents for the boys' home. They came to know the Lord as their Saviour several years ago through Good News Church in our community, and we have seen God working in their lives. We are thankful for their service in the boys home and in helping care for and counsel Timothy during this time. They have three boys of their own: Marcos, Deiber and Lucas. So we now have four girls and three (plus four) boys living in Hogar Shalom.

Praise the Lord the boys have been doing well at school. Despite never having attended school before, Donovan learned to read quickly and was the best reader in his class. In fact, his teacher told me that she would put him to supervise other children to make sure they were reading correctly. In December (end of the school year in Bolivia) he won a prize for the best student in his grade! His older brother Kenai also one best student for his grade! Way to go, Kenai and Donovan!

Please continue to pray for Nahomi. She was beginning to make progress with her reading, but recently has been refusing to read both at home and at school. Due to her past abuse, she often soils her underwear (it is a psychological, not a physical problem). She does not like to wash her clothes so she will fold her soiled undergarments over and shove them in with her clean clothes. Now her whole room smells. Please pray for patience for Lola, the house mother. Pray for Nahomi, that she will begin taking responsibility in this area. Pray that she will feel loved and safe and that she will have a better attitude towards authority. We are thankful that she has come to know Jesus as her Saviour, as His love never fails.
